### TOPICS

The curriculum is divided into 3 modules / 3 days each module / total workload of 72 hours

- Introduction and principles of the "Slavicek concept"
- Fundamentals in model work and facebow, arbitrary and axis mounting
- "How to use" articulator and its additional parts
- Wax up class I
- Repetition of class I, homework control
- Theoretical part about class II, splint therapy, use of CPV (Condylar-Position-Variator)
- Splint production
- Wax up class II
- Repetition of class II, homework control
- Lecture of all classes I / II / III
- Theory about splints according to "Slavicek concept" (retrusive guidance on splint surface)
- Wax up class III
- Repetition of the whole concept, therapeutically overlays
- Discussion about the concept based on cases, different dental classes
