Based on the Continuum „Orthodontics in Craniofacial Dysfunctions“, Prof. Sato developed this course as a progressive continuation of his concept. The course offers the opportunity to deepen the knowledge, finding answers and solving problems to complex cases on a theoretical and practical basis. The purpose is to support dentists, with focus on orthodontics in a more detailed and individual way, acquire solutions together, which then can be applied in their daily work. It allows to advice and exchange on theoretical, as well as practical questions and problems.

- Treatment follow-ups





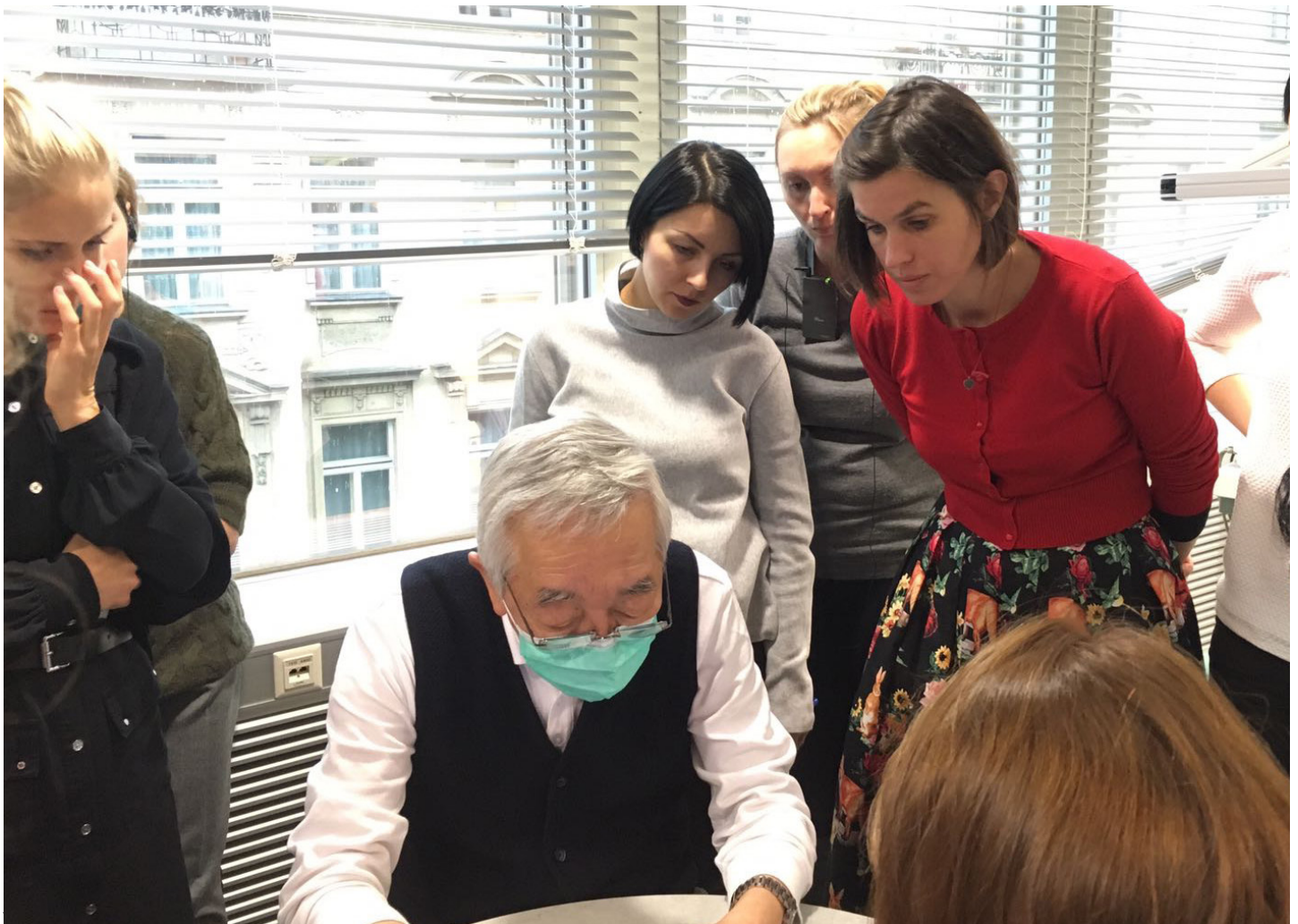
## VieSID Host AND LECTURER

Prof. Dr. Sadao Sato is an internationally recognized specialist in the field of orthodontics. In 1979, he became assistant professor in Kanagawa Dental College. In 1989 he was appointed associate professor. In 1996 he became professor in orthodontics at Kanagawa Dental College and later on he was appointed as dean. Between 1991

and 2001, Prof. Sato was president of the Japan MEAW Technique and Research Foundation. From 1992, he has been member of the Angle Society of Orthodontics. Prof. Sato is a guest professor of the Medical University of Vienna and directs the VieSID Continuum „Orthodontics in Craniofacial Dysfunctions“.
